The Local Trust Committee amends the sign regulations and forwards proposed Bylaw No. 186 to the Executive Committee for approval.

The Denman Island Local Trust Committee gives third reading to proposed Bylaw No. 186, the “Denman Island Land Use Bylaw, 2008,” and forwards it to the Executive Committee for approval. ¹

The committee amends the bylaw’s sign regulations by adding Co-Housing (R3) to the first column, first row of Schedule A, Section 2.6, Regulation 1. ¹

The special meeting is held at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, January 2, 2009, at the Marcus Isbister Old School, with Local Trustees David Graham, chair, and Louise Bell present. ¹

The minutes record three members of the public in attendance. ¹

At the town hall item, Henning Nielsen comments that a density transfer bylaw amendment application will likely be submitted by the end of January. ²
